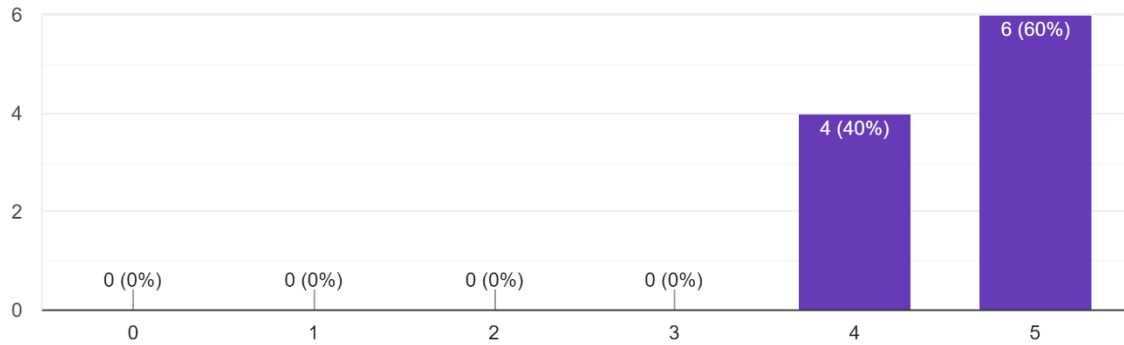

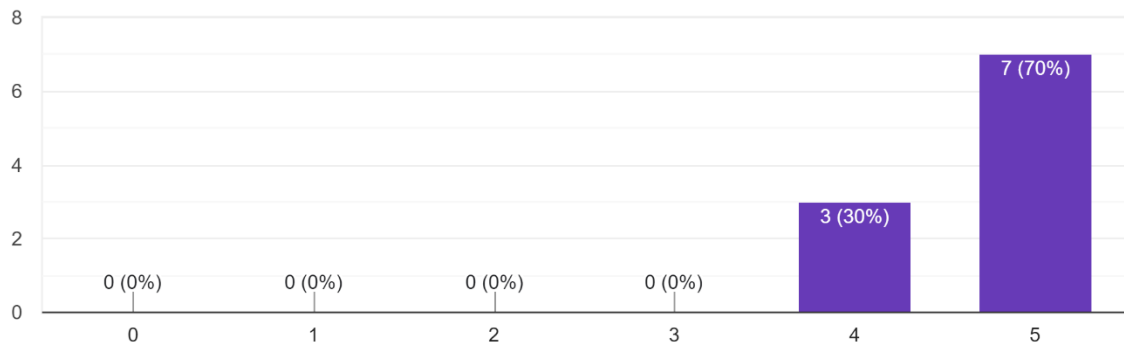
2. Did the workshop meet your expectations?

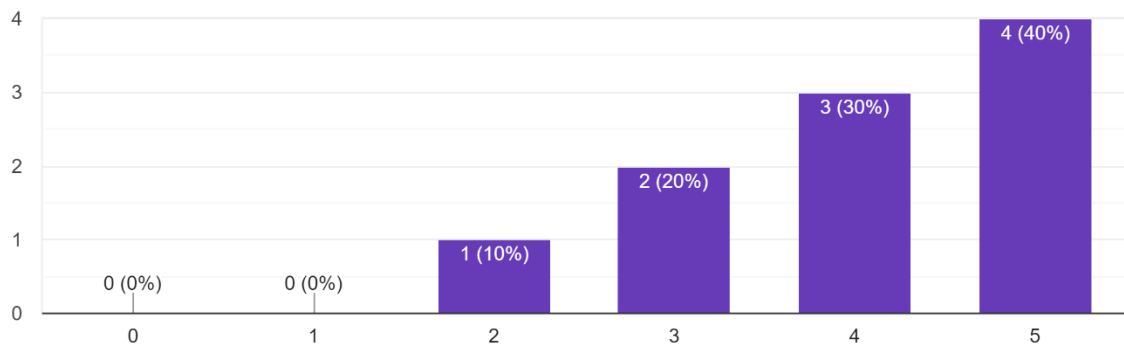
1. How satisfied were you with the workshop?

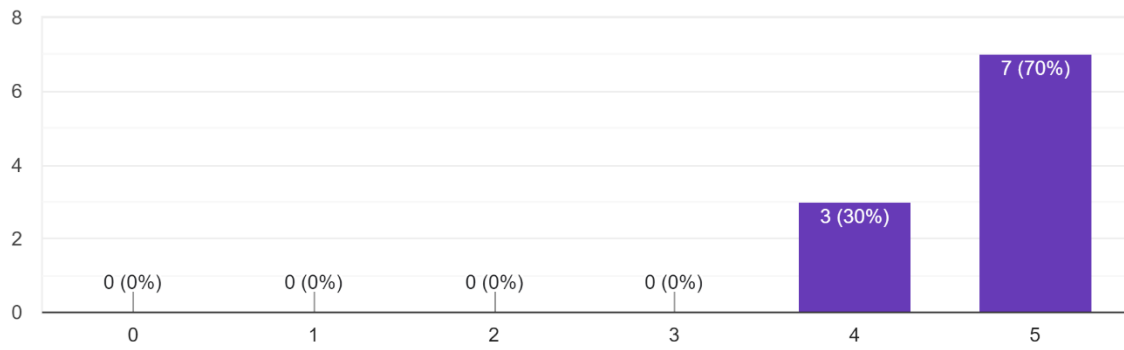
3. Was the workshop relevant to your needs?

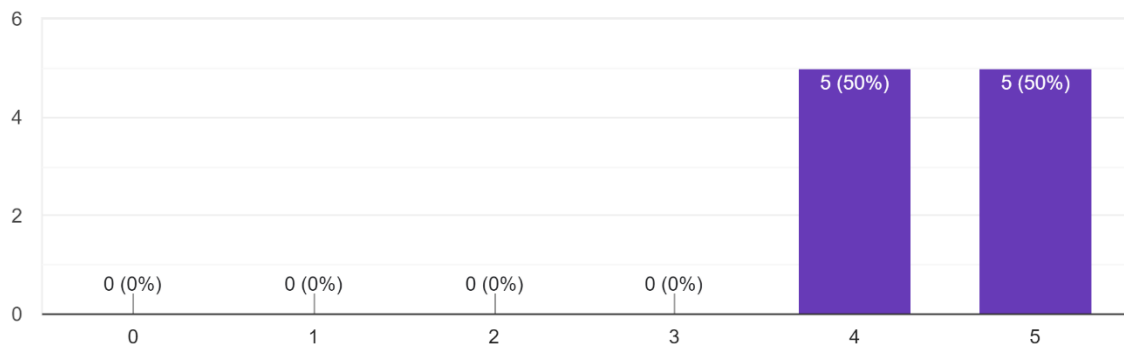
#### 4. Were the objectives of the workshop clearly defined and communicated?

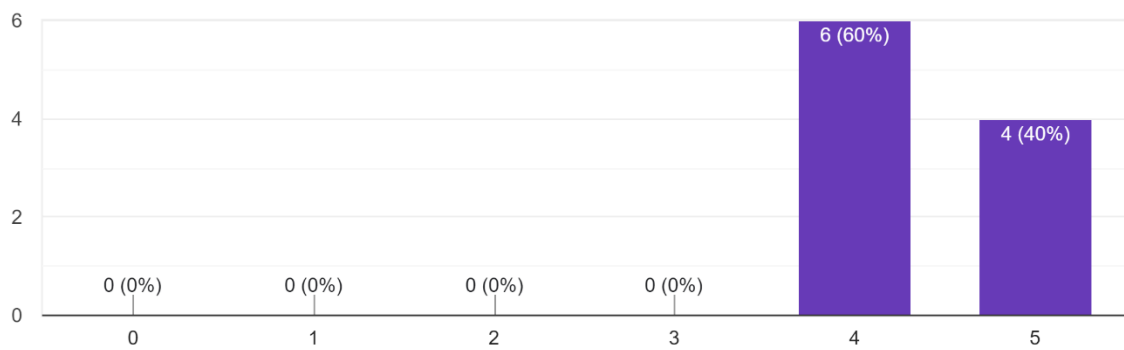

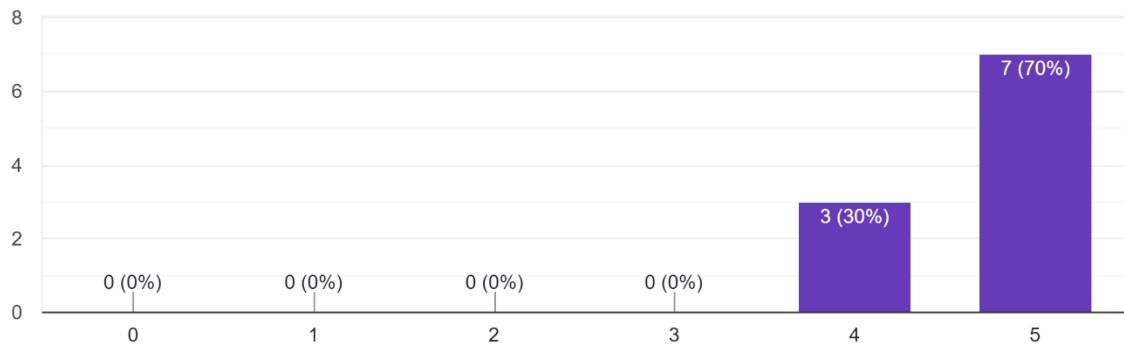

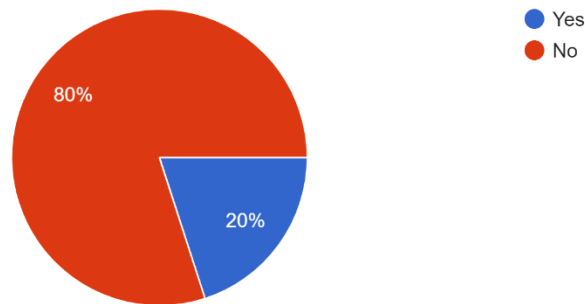

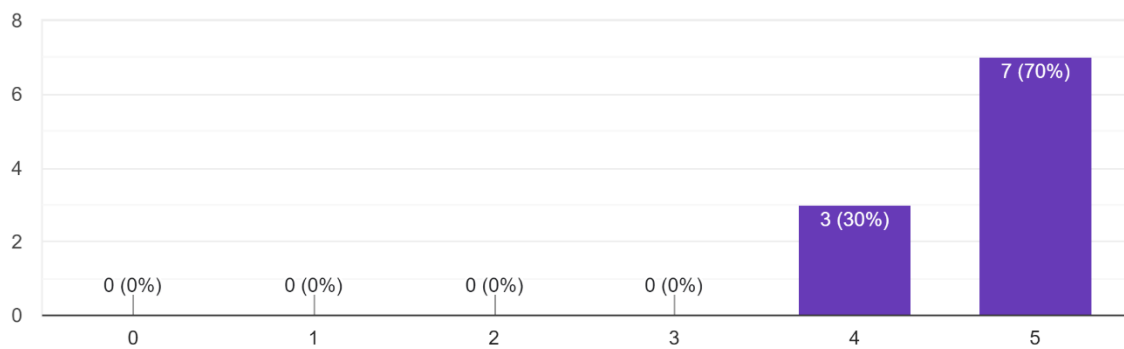

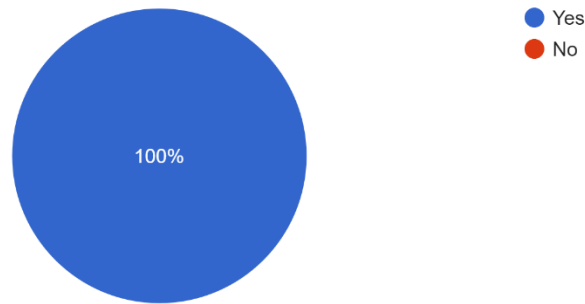

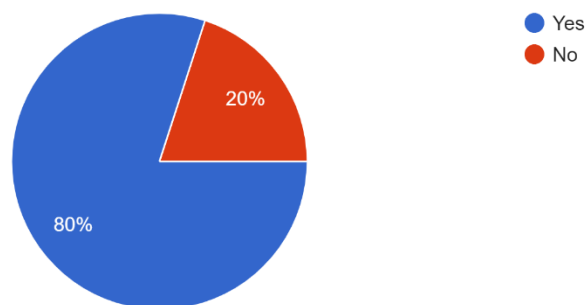

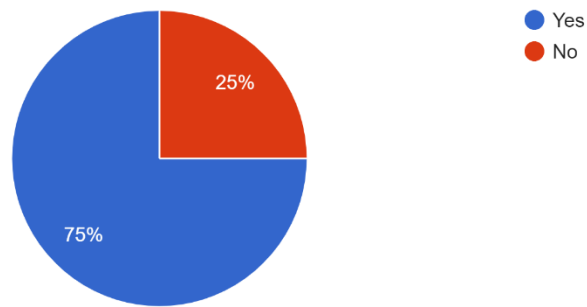
11. Did you submit a problem during the problem-solving activity using post-it?

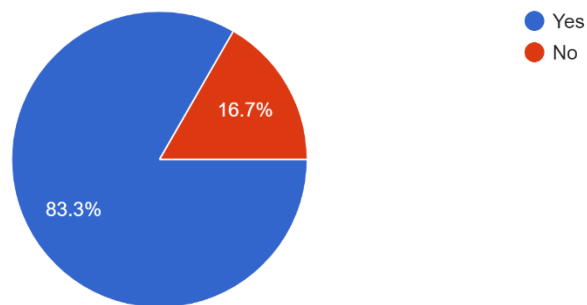
11a. If you submitted a problem, were you satisfied with the answer?

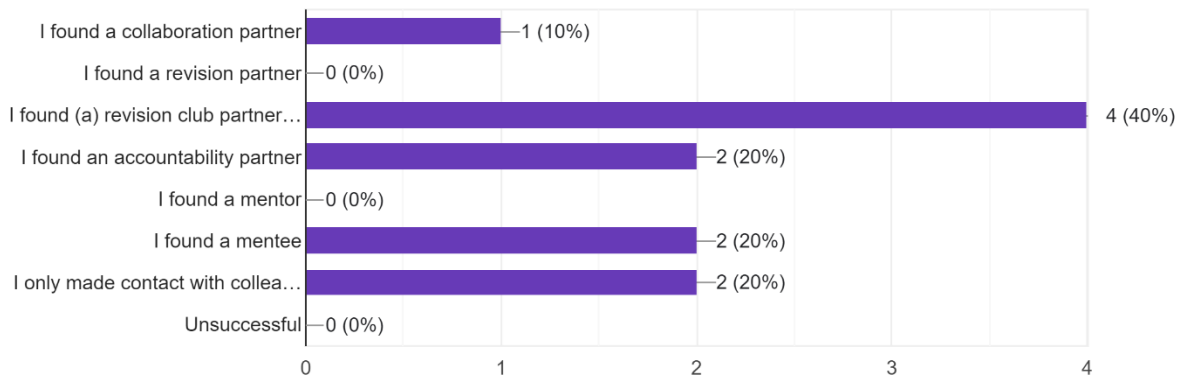
11b. If you said "No", would you like to participate in this type of activity in the future?

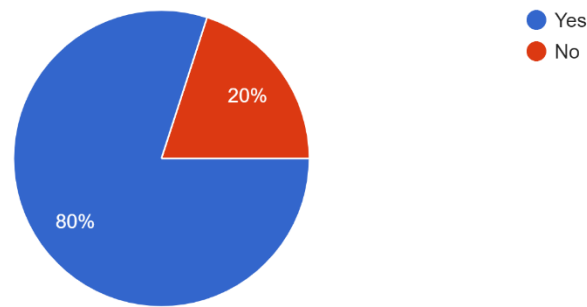
12. Was networking successful during the day?

- Could be followed up with a workshop that incorporates groups working together to help each other on website updates/makeovers, CVs & LinkedIn profiles (based on the Boost Day info), and where members can arrange a language exchange to translate each other's websites/LinkedIn profiles between language pairs
- I think the topics could be developed further in a follow up workshop. It could be on one aspect of the day, such as revision groups, or accountability to give more time to consider one area.
